We are writing to you regarding the proposed decision approving CTF funding for the project preparation grant entitled , *Philippines Cebu Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Demonstration Project* submitted by the government of the Philippines and the World Bank Group and circulated on November 11, 2011, for your review and approval of a CTF allocation of USD 1.0 million.

The member from the United Kingdom requested additional be provided on the proposed project before its approval. The World Bank has provided a response, attached below, to the questions submitted by the UK. Both documents are posted on the CIF password protected website.
