COMMENTS RECEIVED FROM UNITED KINGDOM

With respect to Component B (10 MW Solar Power) of the proposal, we note that the document states that "a substantial number of licenses with power purchase agreements (PPAs) have been granted to developers of solar power (with a total capacity of 200 MW)" and that "these arrangements were made without proper consideration of the ability of the power grid to absorb this much variable power". Our question is:

-By taking actions set out in Component A (Rehabilitation of Distribution Networks), is the project team convinced that the outputs of Component B are additional?

-Is there a risk that the project will displace other investments?

We think the document could be clearer about the market failures which show that Component B is necessary after Component A is completed.
