Objectives

- To provide an opportunity to pilot countries to share early lessons in developing M&E systems in the context of CIF financing.
- To expose CIF stakeholders to critically reflect on key challenges and opportunities in building M&E systems at the programmatic level

Context

Managing the transformation process from a high carbon development scenario towards a low carbon climate resilient growth path is a challenge for most developing countries. M&E systems can play an important role in this transformation process not only in providing the basis for informed management and policy decisions but also giving confidence to investors that results are indeed achieved and communicated across stakeholders.

The M&E session is intended to provide a platform for pilot countries to show how they intend to measure results of climate relevant investments at the outcome level. It is expected that the pilot countries will take the lead in presenting their institutional and organizational setting around M&E in climate adaptation and mitigation. The respective pilot countries will work together with the relevant MDBs and present challenges and opportunities during the process of setting up CIF related M&E systems at the national level and, if feasible, at the project/program level. The presentations in the Partnership Forum will be followed by brief group discussions to provide the whole audience an opportunity to engage in a dialogue and reflect on the challenges CIF pilot countries face. The pilot countries meetings prior to the Partnership Forum provide the pilot countries with an opportunity to present their show cases and discuss some common challenges and ways to address these..
