Welcome back to the PPCR Results Community of Practice! Last week, in response to a community member's request, we provided you with guidance on how to start the core indicator scoring process during your core indicator scoring workshop, starting with core indicators 1 and 2.



## Tips and Tools: Deep Dive - Core Indicators 1 and 2

You may be wondering **why we focus only on core indicators 1 and 2 when starting** the core indicator scoring process. To address this issue, let's take a deeper look at core indicators 1 and 2, and why we deal with these two core indicators differently (we'll explain how you should handle core indicators 3, 4, and 5 in future weeks):

- **Core indicators 1 and 2 are the only core indicators for which you will need to establish baseline data.** Although most of you already established your baseline data last year, we'd like to make sure that those of you who have not yet done so are also up to speed. So, in order to establish a baseline and subsequent monitoring for these core indicators, you should source baseline data from official policy planning documents, as well as national repositories, such as meeting documents, workshop and budget reports, policy papers, and other relevant reports available from the civil society and PPCR stakeholder community.



PPCR CORE INDICATOR 1	<b>Degree of integration of climate change in national, including sector, planning</b>

The purpose of this core indicator is to **assess qualitative changes in the capacity of countries to address climate resilience** through the development of climate plans, strategies and mainstreaming mechanisms and systems. *That said, please keep in mind that the achievement of this indicator cannot be attributed to the PPCR alone.*

- Reference data for this core indicator **should provide evidence about the strength of your country's climate-responsive development planning**, as measured by the extent to which considerations of climate resilience (in terms of risks and opportunities) are integrated into planning processes at national and sectoral levels.



PPCR CORE INDICATOR 2	<b>Evidence of strengthened government capacity and coordination mechanism to mainstream climate resilience</b>

The purpose of this core indicator is to **assess progress towards the goal of a) strengthening government capacity and b) strengthening coordination** for mainstreaming climate resilience.

- Reference data for this core indicator should **provide evidence of enhanced levels of capacity and functionality in institutions, coordination mechanisms, and frameworks** as they have been translated into concrete actions for mainstreaming climate resilience.
