

Consultations on Collaboration to Address Biodiversity Considerations in CIF-funded Wind Projects

Draft Action Plan



Draft Action Plan

- 1. To collate, share and promote experience to-date in considering birds and bats issues when planning wind energy projects supported by the CIF, and if needed prepare additional guidance.
- 2. To develop mapping tools to provide strategic and site-selection guidance on sensitive zones for migratory and resident birds (and bats?) to those developing CIF-financed projects.
- 3. To collate, share and promote experience in the CIF Partnership on the design and operational best practice in avoiding bird and bat mortality and other biodiversity impacts.
- 4. To develop tools for pre- and post-construction monitoring of wind energy projects, and apply these in CIF countries, to assess impacts on birds and other biodiversity.
- 5. To support the development of in-country capacity for avoidance and mitigation of biodiversity concerns in wind energy development within government agencies, civil society and the private sector (developers, consultants etc.).
- 6. To consult on and show-case the results of this collaboration at future CIF Partnership Meetings, and through other forums (such as wind energy conferences) as appropriate.

Scoping missions

To support and advance the development and implementation of this action plan, initial scoping missions are proposed with the following aims:

- 1. To understand the potential risks to birds and bats from poised by CIF projects.
- 2. To understand steps being taken to minimize and mitigate any risks in strategic and project level planning.
- 3. To capture examples of good practice in planning and implementing projects in order to minimize and mitigate these risks, for sharing with the wider CIF partnership.
- 4. To understand current levels of capacity and access to information for addressing these risks.
- 5. To identify future ways in which the pilot countries can strengthen efforts to address biodiversity considerations in wind energy development.

It is proposed that these scoping missions be undertaken between June and October 2012 (for Egypt, South Africa, and Ethiopia?) with reporting back at next CIF Partnership Meeting (Istanbul, Nov 2012).
