Country leadership and alignment with national goals

Programmatic approach from the national broader climate finance scheme

Figure 2. PROGRESS TOWARD TRANSFORMATIONAL CHANGE ACROSS DIMENSIONS








Using Mural

• Use the Outline on the right of your screen to easily navigate to specific sections of the Mural board


• To zoom in and out, either use your mouse or the tool on the bottom right of your screen (which also allows you to move around the Mural board)






Working in Mural
