### MfDR — Two Pronged Approach


- Adoption of MfDR approaches within the Donor Community

- Uniform RF and other related tools at the Country Level
- Pilot Countries Integrate RF as a sector RF into the National RF
- Harmonize Project DMF of DPs
- Develop Monitoring Matrix for annual monitoring of results
- Capacity Building activities for results monitoring within SREP at the country level
