



Energy Transition

HIGHLIGHTS

- Strategic Modalities on Use of CTF Resources: Options paper completed for TFC discussion
- CTF Portfolio Update:
 - USD 5.2 billion for 162 TFC approved projects from 16 country and regional IPs and five phases of DPSP
 - Anticipated co-financing: USD 56.1 billion
 - 3 new projects approved: 1 GESP in Maldives, 2 Futures Window in Africa
 - MDBs disbursed USD 2.9 billion for 117 projects
- **ACT:** The Phillipinnes IP submitted for TFC approval; IP process progresses further in North Macedonia and Dominican Republic.
- Industry Decarbonization:
 - Design Document circulated for feedback and finalization before COP
 - Integrated Results Framework to be completed in December 2023
- Technical Assistance Facility: Launched the 4th call-for-proposals for remaining funds available, to be concluded by end-2023



Energy Transition

UPCOMING

ACT IP and project development:

- North Macedonia IPs expected by end-2023
- India and Dominican Republic IPs expected during FY24
- South Africa and Indonesia expected to submit first projects in FY24
- ReACT Tool: Exploring real-world demonstration opportunities with partner MDBs and other stakeholders
- Industry Decarbonization. Fundraising to continue through and beyond COP 28, design document to be reviewed and approved by TFC before end-2023, Integrated Resutls Framework to be completed by December 2023.

TAF: Upcoming studies on financial sector intermediation in Latin America; analysis of Covid19 green and resilient recovery projects, among others.





Energy Access & Integration

Highlights

- V New REI IPs proposed by Costa Rica, Fiji
- SREP: Continued interest from SREP countries (non-REI) Confirmed to utilize unused SREP funds

Upcoming

- REI IPs expected by end-November: Kenya, Ukraine, possibly Indonesia and Turkiye
- SREP: CIF and MDB Committee to discuss potential new projects for the SREP pipeline by end-November

HIGHLIGHTS

CCMM Structure

- Enhanced liquidity accepted by all stakeholders
- Pari passu accepted by some countries

Credit Rating Agency Engagement

- Consolidated data from six MDBs for three years, two scenarios (PP and non-PP)
- Submitted to Moody's and S&P in Oct, Fitch in Nov/Dec.
- Preliminary assessment expected during or after COP 28

- Finalize CCMM structure pending rating assessments
- Contributors to seek internal approval of final documents
- Incorporate CCMM Issuer and obtain final public credit rating

HIGHLIGHTS

- Four additional NPC Scoping Missions completed (Brazil, Egypt, Fiji, Namibia)
- Selection by NPC MDB committee of World Bank to lead Global Component of NPC DGM
- NPC Learning Platform Launched
- FIP Pipelining process of >\$20m for 5 project concepts approved, including 2-year extension of FIP DGM Global project

UPCOMING

- All 10 programs in NPC portfolio now planning their Joint Missions with many programs on track for IP Submission during June TFCs
- New **M&R Toolkit roll out** for NPC
- FIP-DGM Mid-term evaluation report

Resilience and Adaptation

HIGHLIGHTS

- Positive response to the Climate Resilience Program (CRP) proposal
- Climate Smart Cities Program capitalized at \$20million was profiled at MENA Climate Week, as a possible source of climate finance to cities.
- Building strategic partnerships with GCoM, C40 and CCFLA highlighting complementary strengths should lend to coherence/defragmentation.

UPCOMING

- Climate Smart Urbanization program, current focus is on awareness-raising, establishing strategic partnerships, and building momentum towards fullfledged fundraising in 2024.
- With sufficient capitalization, CIF is working toward the EoI process with independent experts' panel review by 2025.





- Developed strategic partnerships with UNFCCC, CEM, UNIDO, Jane Goodall Institute in support of Programs.
- In FY24, expect to launch Industry Decarbonization EOI in alignment with G20 and Climate Club priorities. Fundraising for Cities Program and potentially CRP will commence, engaging new civil society actors.
- Communications Strategy 2023 2026 is being implemented.

- Long standing (3 years) collaboration platform on Results and Impact to promote consistency and harmonization of indicators, methods, and approaches
- Evaluation units holding quarterly collaboration workshops; GCF part of CIF Evaluation and Learning Advisory Group
- All funds part of Transformational Change Learning Partnership (TCLP)

Stakeholder Engagement

Strengthening Role of Observers

- Joint initiatives by Stakeholder Engagement Team and Evaluation & Learning Team in partnership with the Global Evaluation Initiative
- Two training workshops for 40 Observers (in Brasilia and Washington)
- Sept 2023, an Expression of Interest launched to provide up to 4 research grants for CIF Observers to undertake evaluative studies (\$50k each)
- 8 observers joined the TCLP workshop on 16-18 October in Washington
- Rotation of CIF Observers to the Joint CTF-SCF TFC completed. Term extended to Dec 2024

Youth Engagement

- Launched the global **CIF Youth Fellowship Program** in partnership with six MDBs
- Seven young professionals (selected from over 3,000 applications) will work with the MDB's in **country offices** (India, Egypt, Kenya, Jamaica, Thailand, and Tunisia).
- **Onboarded the Fellows in a weeklong program** in Ghana from 16-22 October.







Gender and Stakeholder Engagement

Inclusivity

HIGHLIGHTS

- Women Climate Leadership: deeper collaboration with MDBs: capacity-building, MDB knowledge exchange, joint events
- WOLCOT: Creation of an Advisory group, technical support and coordination for allocated small grants in Indonesia/South Africa
- **Disability Inclusion**: Background paper on *Disability inclusion in Climate Finance* and in-country technical consultations

UPCOMING

- Women Climate Leadership : country application workshops (Dominican Republic, Indonesia, Congo Rep.), and dissemination events : ADB gender forum, internal events at WB and IDB
- WOLCOT: Technical consultations in Indonesia, Second call to support India, Philippines, Dominican Republic and North Macedonia
- Disability Inclusion: sectoral guidance notes, deep-dives in selected countries
- GESIFY: Knowledge collaboration on gender in financial intermediaries

HIGHLIGHTS

- Filled five vacancies, which were under recruitment since FY23, notably the lead position for CCMM, and vacancies in the Portfolio, E&L, and Gender teams.
- We also strengthened the governance, program, and portfolio teams by reassigning current staff, including the lead position for Governance.

UPCOMING

- Y Two-phased recruitment approach.
- Batch 1 (October-December 2023): We will fill 10 positions outlined in the budget to address the most pressing operational demands.
- Batch 2 (June December 2024): the remaining 10 proposed positions for Batch 2 recruitment, some of which should require further assessment and judgment by the Incoming CEO.
