### 6. Visa Requirements

http://www.usembassy.gov. Please note that it can take up to four weeks to obtain a US Visa.

A transit visa may be required when connecting/transiting through certain countries. Please review your flight itinerary to ensure that needed transit visas have been obtained. Note: the issuance of a transit visa may take up to 10 business days.

Although no longer a requirement, please always carry your Covid-19 vaccine cards in case the U.S. customs agent requests it upon your arrival to the country. The <a href="CDC website">CDC website</a> is a good source of formal reference.
