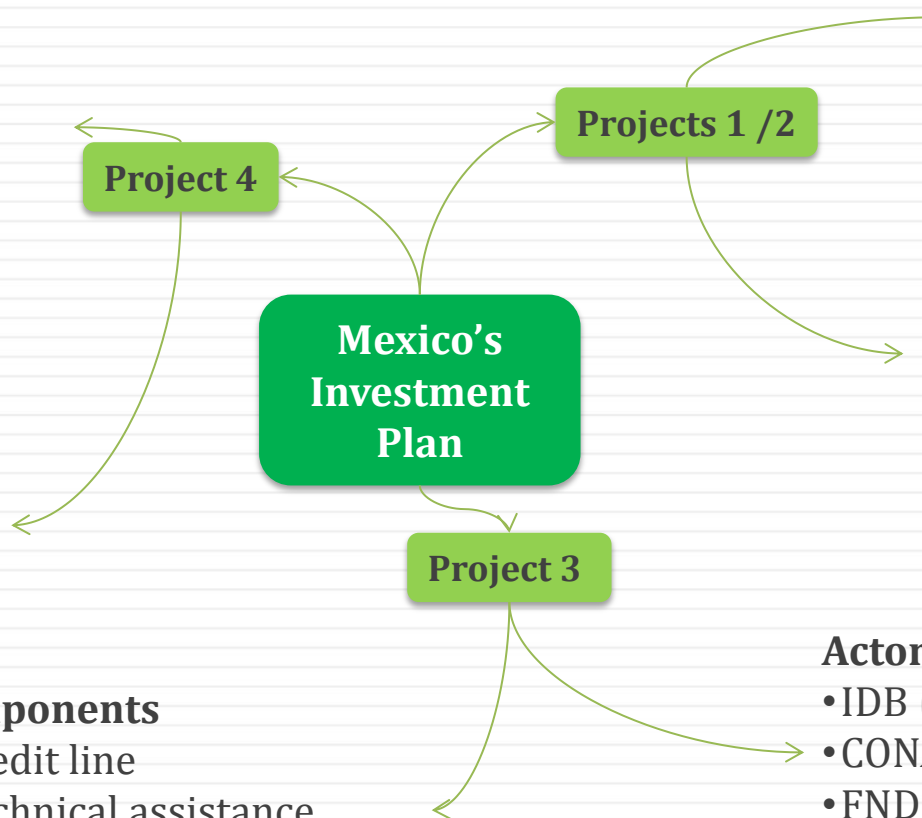

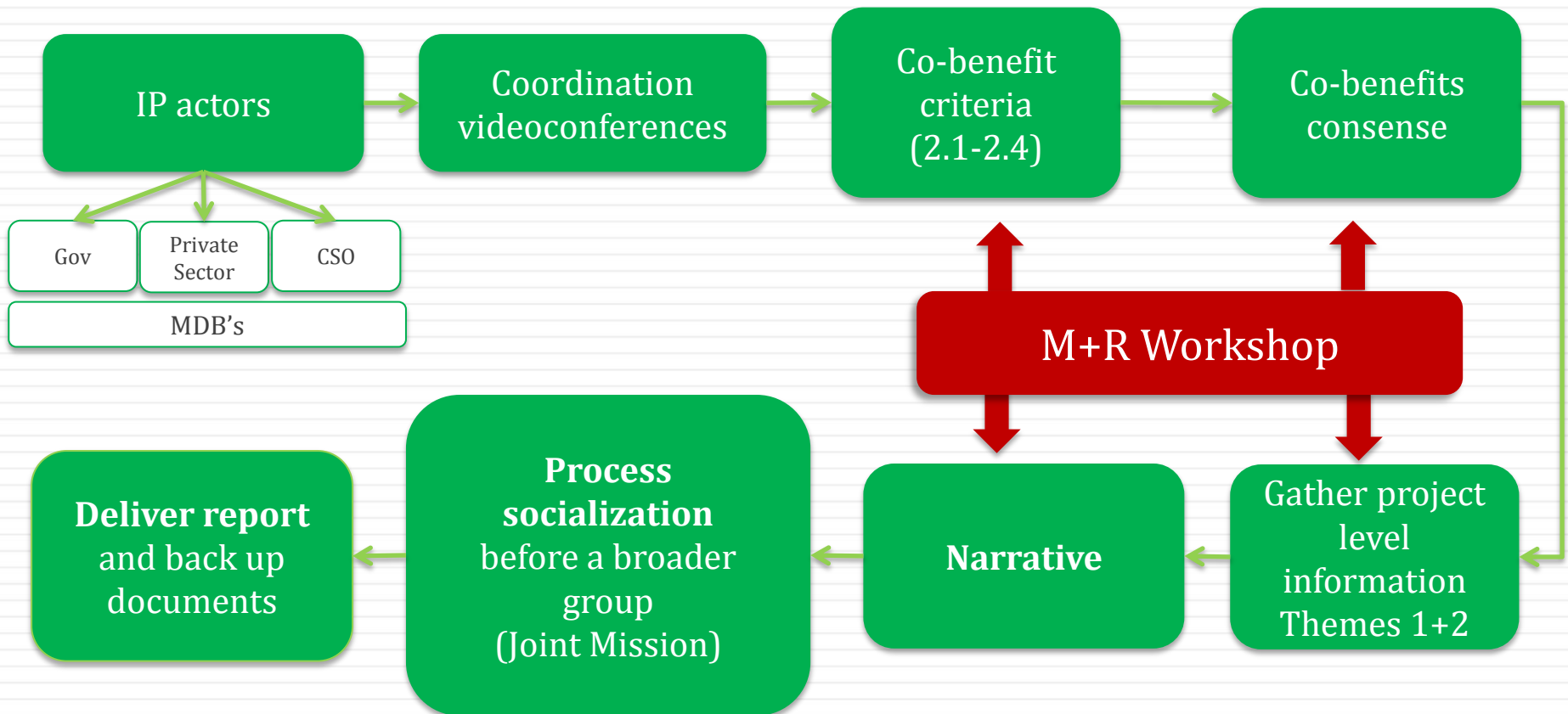

Videoconferences

1. Present integration strategy and reporting timeline.
2. Analyze early criteria and evaluation proposals for theme 2.
3. Clarify reporting of theme 1 indicators.

- Work groups accordingly to area of expertise to determine criteria
- Plenary discussion to validate criteria
- Evaluation in work groups
- Plenary discussion to agree on evaluation

Joint Mission

CONAFOR, as FIP focal point in Mexico, calls for a Joint Mission, an annual multi-stakeholder meeting to review the implementation of the FIP investment plan.

M+R process socialization with a wider stakeholder group to share the criteria and scores.

Lessons Learned

1. When homologating criteria with different executing agencies, it is helpful to establish in advance, the evidences to support those decisions.
2. Multi-stakeholder meetings helps articulate the four FIP projects, showing how each one contributes to the expected outcomes.
3. Report IP results, must be based upon the existing national measuring tools and current M&E system.
4. Governance theme could involve fewer and less complex criteria
