- A UN partnership (FAO/UNDP/UNEP) established to support REDD+ readiness in the context of the UNFCCC
- Main aim: To support developing countries build capacity to participate in a future REDD+ system
 - assisting countries to set up REDD+ systems that align with the UNFCCC agreements: *Cancun Agreements* (2010) and Warsaw climate framework (2013)
- **Secondary aim:** Develop best international practice for REDD+ (e.g. tools, methodologies, knowledge management, south-south exchanges)
- **Key donors:** Norway, the European Union, Spain, Denmark, Japan, Luxembourg
- Total contribution: 256 millions USD








Total of 60 Partner Countries

Highlights of Progress

MRV and Monitoring

• 29 countries designing/building NFMS (NFI, SLMS and GHG Inventory)

Governance

• 6 countries with National REDD+ Strategy/Roadmap/Phase 2 account

Stakeholder Engagement


 27 countries have activities/mechanisms to support participation of CSO, IP and forestdependent communities

Safeguards and Multiple Benefits

• 6 countries have country approach to safeguards an/or incorporated multiple benefits in REDD+ planning

Green Economy and Private Sector Engagement

- 3 countries are establishing National Platforms for key driver commodities
- 10 countries carried out key background studies and analysis for National REDD+ Strategy design


